Easton's Nook invites writers and academics in the humanities, arts, social sciences, and STEM disciplines to join us for a 6 night, 7 day writing retreat in Negril, Jamaica. Participants will write on-site in a beautiful and idyllic seaside environment.

What do costs cover and what will you experience during the writing retreat?

Airfare is NOT included in the cost of the retreat. The cost of the retreat covers the following:



Protected Writing Time: 30 + hours of protected writing time.



Topical and Disciplinary Affinity Groups: Build professional networks and explore ideas with scholars pursuing scholarship in your areas of interest.



Professional Development Workshops: Explore questions about pathways to writing productivity, success, and leadership in the academy.



Group Morning Wellness Activities



Ground transportation from airport in Jamaica to writing site, and from writing site to airport for return to the US.

What are the Cottages/Accommodations Like?

Our writing site has 17 private cottages and multiple private and communal spaces where you can write. Three types of cottages are available: garden cottages, rooftop cottages, and seaside cottages. Go to the Easton's Nook RESERVATIONS page to select your cottage.

Garden Cottages (actual view)



Garden Cottages are located on the ground level with a private patio offering endless views of different species of tropical flora & fauna. These suites feature a king-sized bed, a large private bathroom, and view of the lush tropical vegetation.

Rooftop Cottages (actual view)



Rooftop Cottages are located on the second level offering ample space and a private covered balcony. These suites feature a king-sided bed, a large private bathroom, and expansive views of the Caribbean Sea or gardens.

Seaside Cottages (actual view)



Seaside Cottages offer a kingsized bed, full ocean views overlooking an ocean-fed pool and the Caribbean Sea. These cottages have a private open-air balcony, and a large private bathroom.

How many spots are available? Space is limited. Only 17 spots are available for each retreat.

What is the **full** cost of the Writing Retreat?

- Garden Cottages (garden view, 1 Queen bed) 5 available \$3950 per person, single occupancy
- Rooftop Cottage (ocean view, 1 King bed) 5 available \$4250 per person, single occupancy
- Seaside Cottage (ocean view, 1 King bed) 7 available \$4400 per person, single occupancy

Costs include lodging, all meals, roundtrip ground transportation between airport and writing site, professional development workshops, affinity groups, wellness activities, and all taxes and gratuities. Air fare is not included. *NOTE:* Please consult your tax advisor about the tax deductibility of this writing retreat.

What are the payment options? Hold your space with a \$500 non-refundable deposit.
